Rules & Regulations: We encourage you to go to www.bracesbrigade.org to review all the FAQs and RULES, but here are a few items of most importance to note if you want to consider being a blogger:

- Due to legal restrictions the Braces Brigade is only open to entrants 14 years old and older. If you're between the ages of 14 and 18, you must have a parent or legal guardian fill out the Parental Consent Form in order to be considered for the Braces Brigade.
- The AAO will choose up to ten (10) bloggers to participate in the Brigade. They are looking for bloggers who reflect a variety of stages in their orthodontic treatment or their child's treatment.
- All submissions will be reviewed by a panel of judges based on the following criteria: quality and writing skill (40%), story content – emotional or humorous (25%), appropriateness of content (25%) and completeness of submission (10%).
- They ask that you make an eight month commitment to blog 100 words or more at least once each month (and they would like for you to include a photo or video each time). Don't worry if you have writers block; they supply you with lots of lead questions to help you write with ease. It could be a lot of fun for you and have a great impact on others.
- The ten Braces Brigade winners will be selected in October and will be notified by email.
- All content will be owned by the AAO but the bloggers will be able to reuse their post (i.e. on their Facebook page or on our website) with permission.

If you think you have some fun or interesting stories to tell about your or your child's orthodontic treatment, go ahead and apply. Who knows, maybe you will be one of the lucky people selected as part of the Braces Brigade!



LUNCHBOX IDEAS WILL MAKE THEM GIGGLE!

1. Pita-Butter and Jelly
